

Set Parent's Time Commitment and Responsibilities

Time commitment

- *You must be able to attend the rehearsal on March 18th*. You will only have to stay for the set you will be working with and the times will be given to you after we set the schedule. Unfortunately, this is not a position you can just "wing". It takes organization and communication that will make the kids and the adults more calm and coordinated the night of the show.
- The night of show we need you there **by 6:40 pm** and the show ends around 9:00pm - 9:30pm depending on the acts.

Main Responsibilities (will supply more details at rehearsal)

- Manage a group of 4 - 7 acts of students in your set.
- Need to organize the students into their correct seats the night of the show, **March 19th**.
- Need students to be quiet out of respect for other students and make sure they have everything they need to go on the stage.
- Need to bring students backstage at the appropriate time. Need to keep students quiet and organized back stage (they are nervous and excited at this time especially) and bring them back to their seats after the set.
- Hold onto any valuables during the show and coordinate their snacks in a central area.
